UDOIT (Universal Design Online (content) Inspection Tool)

Overview

UDOIT is a tool to help instructors discover and repair accessibility issues in their online courses. UDOIT scans their courses, identifies possible visual accessibility issues, and gives tips on how to repair the issues.

In late 2013, the proposal submitted by the Center for Distributed Learning won Instructure, Inc.'s Canvas Grant in the higher education category for its novel Canvas integration idea of quickly identifying accessibility issues in online courses. The \$10,000 grant was awarded to UCF – CDL to take an existing tool and further develop this solution into what is now known as the UDOIT tool.

Future Plans

CDL plans to release UDOIT to the Instructure Canvas community June 1, 2015 via GitHub in time for the 2015 InstructureCon event. At this event, CDL staff will share outcomes from the awarded grant.

Items to Consider Before Releasing UDOIT to the Community

- UDOIT uses the QUAIL PHP library (<https://code.google.com/p/quail-lib/>), which has been heavily customized to suit the needs of UDOIT. This library requires distribution of tools developed with their library under the GNU General Public License version 3 (<http://www.gnu.org/licenses/gpl.html>) (APPENDIX A).
- Distribution of UDOIT will also require the Composer PHP library (<https://getcomposer.org>) which is distributed under the MIT license (<https://github.com/composer/composer/blob/master/LICENSE>) (APPENDIX B)
